*Vellum Cabernet Sauvignon 2007 is an ultra-premium Napa Valley wine made in the style of the St-Julien region of Bordeaux, France. It is a blend of three grape varieties: 84% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Merlot, and 6% Petit Verdot.*

## TASTING NOTES

*Made in a French style with bright acidity and lower alcohol, the 2007 VELLUM Cabernet Sauvignon is beautiful and elegant with superb balance and perfectly ripened fruit. The wine opens with aromas of espresso grounds, graphite, dark fruit and cardamom. The palate ties in with the nose and transitions seamlessly. The acid backbone frames the entire mouth and lets the powdery tannins fall gently front to back. The tannin, acid and alcohol are well integrated and provide for a very long finish. (Only 800 cases produced)*
