## TASTING NOTES

*The 2010 Vellum Black beams confidence and presence in every regard. It is classic in stature and form and bounds from the glass to immediately grab attention. The nose is loaded with heady notes of wild blueberry, cassis and exotic spice all sinuously entwined. The palate delivers intense succulent dark fruit matched to the nose, but completing with a foundation of late summer understory and a lingering sweet tar. This ample wine stretches its frame with purpose in length and breadth, carrying adroit focused tannin uninterrupted to a long satisfying and persistent finish. It is the highest expression of Petit Verdot, age worthy 25+ years and the crown of an unforgettable vintage! (8 barrels produced)*
