Vellum Cabernet Sauvignon 2010 is an ultra-premium Napa Valley wine made in the spirit of old French classics with high acidity and well-integrated alcohol, oak and tannin. Vellum Wine Craft was founded with a singular vision – to elevate Cabernet Sauvignon to its highest level of purity and grace.

TASTING NOTES

Wild aromas of vibrant cassis, understory, and sweet tarry tobacco bound up from the wine. There is a final heady note of raw cocoa that continues on to the palate. Here blacker forest fruits emerge and knit with flavours of tar, minerals, bramble and winter mulling spices. Fine tannin is layered and tightly woven onto a seamless and highly structured frame. The wine finally descends as a capacious wave, moving with traction and purpose to a long succulent finish.
