## TASTING NOTES

*The 2011 Vellum Cabernet Sauvignon opens up with deep and entwined aromas of red gooseberry, understory, dusty earth, cardamom, incense of myrrh, and fresh sage. The intense impact of the nose lingers into a seamless transition on the palate. The wine reflects the pedigree of Coombsville with unctuous flavours of bright red cherry, cranberry, graphite, tarragon and ground winter spices. The palate is broad at every point and falls front to back with a signature supple airiness completing in a very long warm finish.*
